



Georgia GED® Testing Program GED® Updates

All test-takers, including 16 & 17 year olds, will register, schedule and pay for the GED® Test at www.ged.com or call the toll free number 1-877-EXAM GED or 1-877-392-6433.

The GED® Test is completely computer-based and includes four content-area individual test. The content-areas are:

[Reasoning through Language Arts](#) (RLA) 155 - minutes

[Mathematical Reasoning](#) (Math)- 120 minutes

[Science](#) – 95 minutes

[Social Studies](#) – 75 minutes

The Score Performance Levels are:

Pass / High School Equivalency	≥ 145
GED® College Ready	≥ 165
GED® College Ready + Credit	≥ 175

Testing Fees

- \$40.00 per content-area test or \$160.00 for all four content-area tests.
- GED® Testing Service is offering a GED® Test Retake Program to assist test-takers who fail a portion of the GED® Test. This means that Georgia test-takers will pay \$20.00 for the first two retakes if the retakes occur within 12 calendar months.

Georgia Policies for the GED® Test

- The State of Georgia has a 60-day waiting period after three unsuccessful attempts are made per subtest.
- The GED® Ready, the new Official Practice Test requirements for Underage Youth: 16 & 17 years old is passing two subtests with a minimum score of at least 150.
- The required pass score on the GED® Ready is 145 for 18 years old and older.
- The GED® Ready and the GED® Test have a score report after each test that tells test-takers what areas they need to work on in order to be successful. The score report offers different modes of study such as Kaplan, Aztec, and the study GED® book. There is no need to guess what areas a test-taker needs to study.
