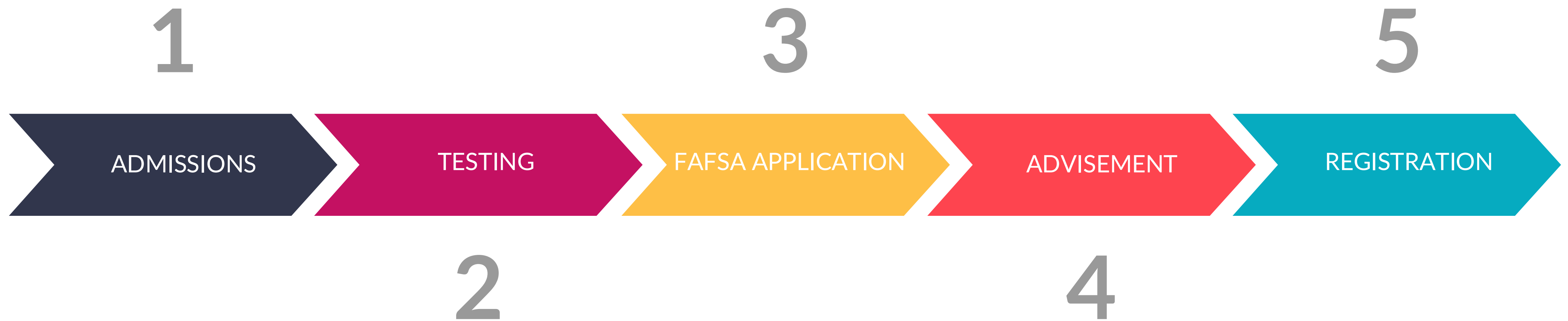


Culinary Degree Sample Academic Track

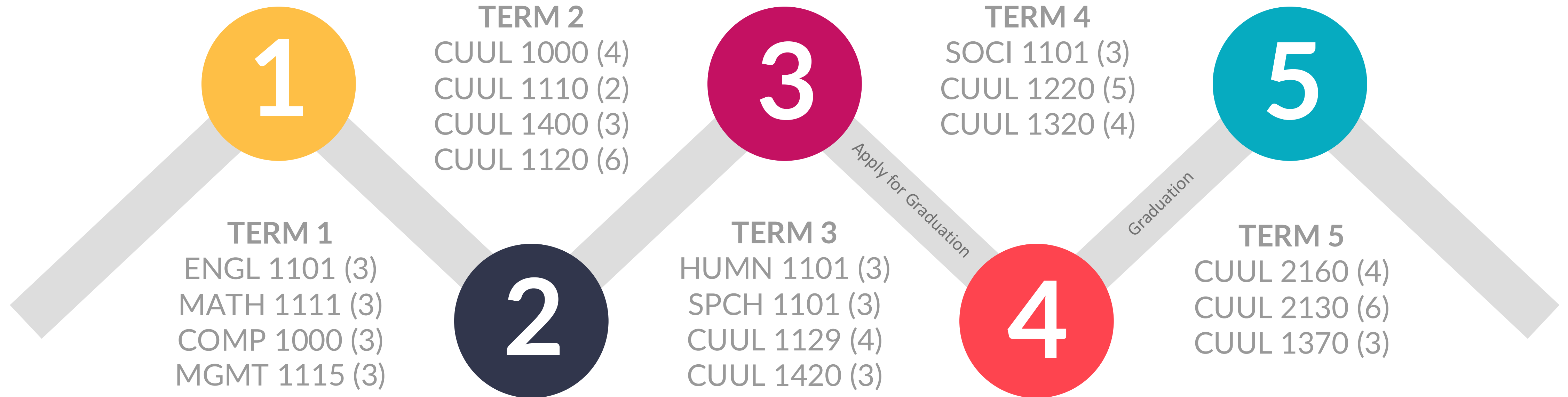
Credits required for graduation: 65
