

Completing the required 52 credits for graduation Students will be able to demonstrate procedures and resources used in the identification and assessment of automotive collision damages, and mixing, matching, and applying various types of Automotive Paints to Industry Standards. Graduates emerge as qualified Automotive Collision Repair Technicians and Automotive Refinishing Technicians, ready to take on qualification tests that further validate their expertise.
