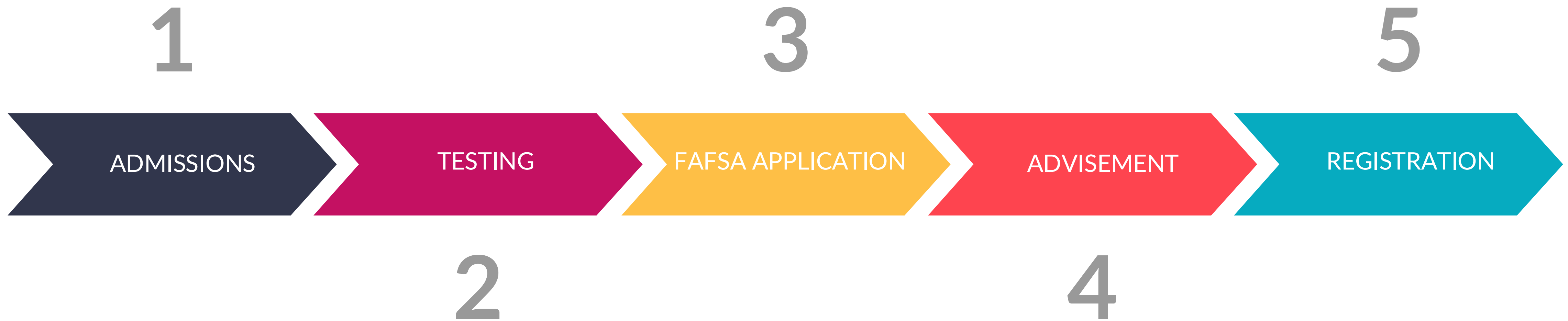


Accounting Degree Sample Academic Track

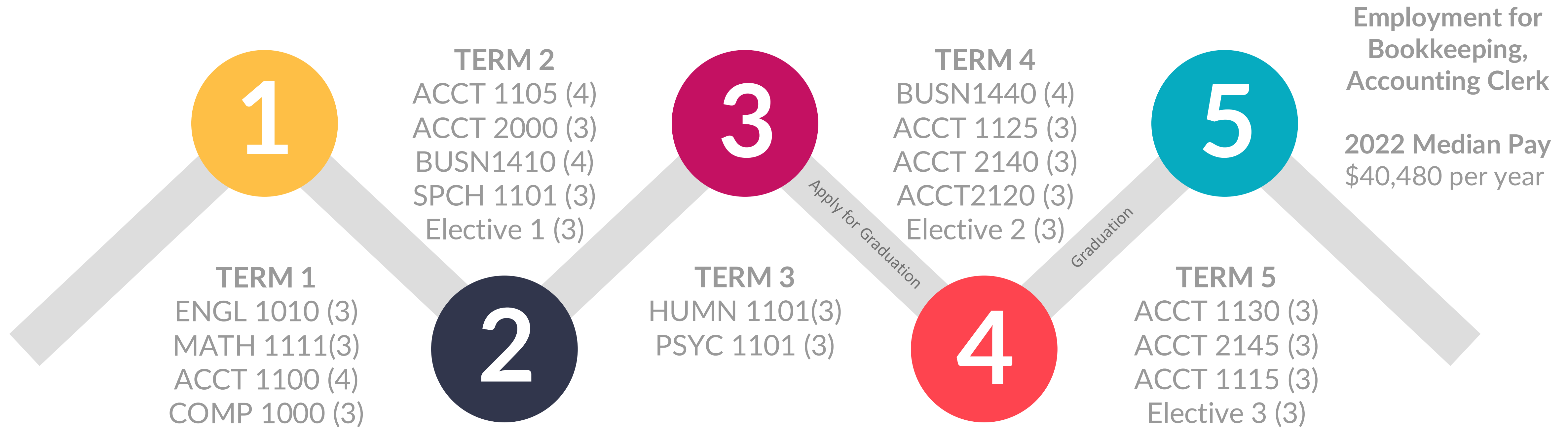
Credits required for graduation: 64

The accounting industry offers substantial earning potential. According to data from 2022, the annual mean wage of bookkeeping, accounting and auditing clerks in Albany, GA was \$40,480 per year, or \$19.46 per hour.

Completing the required 64 credits for graduation is ready for a variety of careers as bookkeeping, payroll clerks, accounting clerks, and other accounting related professionals and/or immediately continue their education toward a Bachelor of Science in Accounting degree at Albany State University, Georgia SouthWestern State University, and Valdosta State University.
