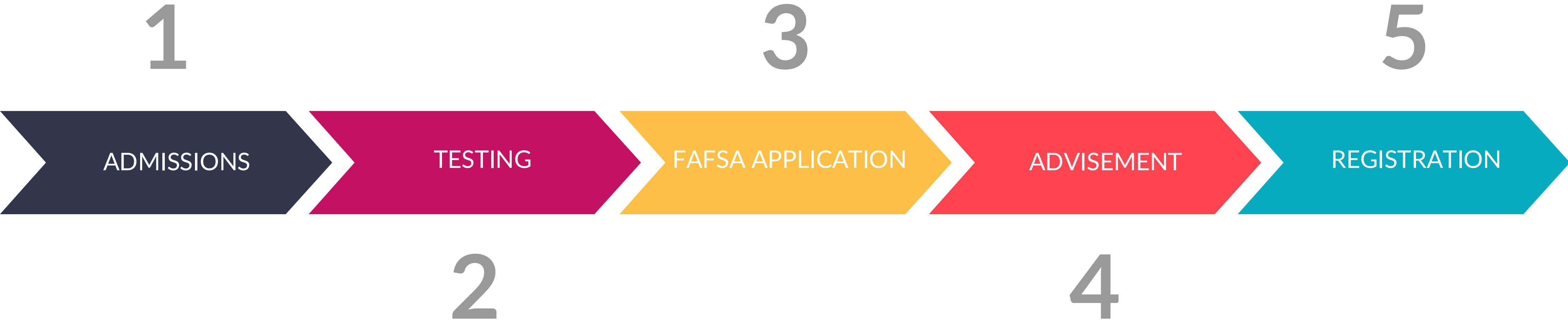


Dental Assisting Diploma Sample Academic Track

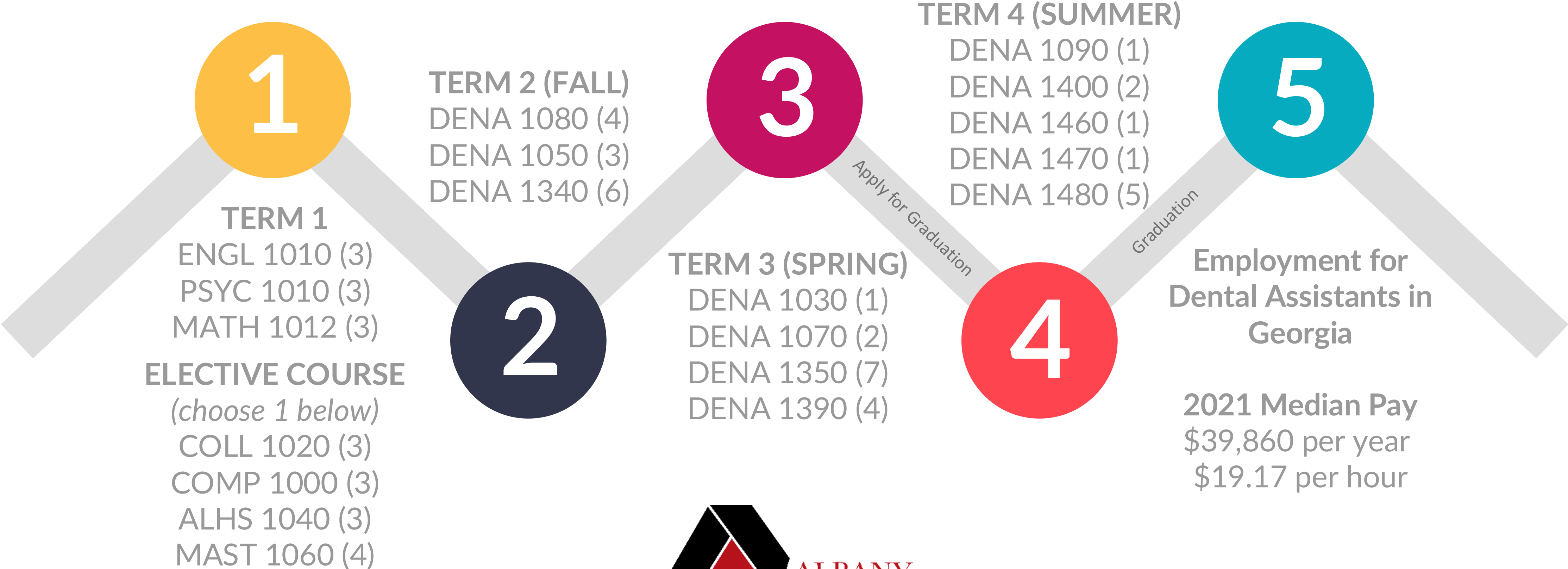
Credits required for graduation: 54 - 55

The Dental Assisting diploma molds students into skilled and certified Georgia expanded duty dental assistants. It combines academic and technical training for job readiness and advancement, focusing on both dental assisting theory and hands-on practice. Graduates are set to pursue a career in dentistry with certifications in Dental Radiology, Georgia Expanded Duties, Coronal Polishing and the opportunity to obtain the Dental Assisting National Board Certified Dental Assistant credential.

Dental Assisting

The dental assisting industry offers substantial earning potential. According to data from 2021, the median pay for dental assistants in the state of Georgia was \$39,860 per year, or \$19.17 per hour.

Completing the required 54-55 credits for graduation is akin to the technical areas of preventive dentistry; four-handed dentistry; chairside assisting with emphasis in diagnostics, operative, fixed prosthodontics, pediatric dentistry, orthodontic procedures, endodontic procedures, surgical specialties, and expanded duties; dental practice management; and dental radiology.. Graduates emerge certified in Georgia Expanded Duties for Dental Assistants, Dental Radiology, Coronal Polishing, and are given the opportunity to sit for the Dental Assisting National Board certification exam for the Certified Dental Assistant Credential.
